As you are aware, the municipal parking deck project is well underway. We appreciate your patience with the limited traffic pattern so far.

The next phase of the project is to excavate the deep footings. To allow for this deep excavation, we will need to drive large sheet piles. This will require a crane to be used during the week of 1/23/12. As such, at certain times we will need to block both lanes of Wilsey Way and Horner St. where the crane is situated, and around its swing radius.

Please note, during this work an entrance to each level of the parking deck will be made accessible. During this week, two way traffic will be temporarily restored from both Robbins Lane and Horner St. up to where the crane is at that time.

The movement of the crane will be daily, so signs will be posted to help guide vehicles to the deck entrances. Sometimes, a trip around the block may be needed to access a particular level .
